SCIENCE PROGRAMS

Animal Kingdom *Grades K-2*

Animals can be classified into many different groups. Each week we will learn how scientists classify animals such as mammals, birds, reptiles, and amphibians based on their similarities and differences.

Planet Earth *Grades 2-5*

Each visit will introduce students to a new habitat or biome. We'll travel to the world's jungles, deserts, forests, and oceans without ever leaving school! This program will give students a chance to think globally about environmental issues threatening our planet and learn all about animals of the world.

Junior Naturalists *Grades K-5*

The Junior Naturalist Program gives students the opportunity to expand their knowledge of native wildlife. Each session will explore the relationships between local plants and animals, ecology, and ways to protect the environment.

Mad Scientists *Grades K-5*

Endless amounts of wonder can be sparked through science exploration. But, is there a method behind the madness? Through hands on, in-class experiments, students will become real scientists who strive to answer the big questions like "what," "how", and "why".

ART PROGRAMS

Wildlife Illustration *Grades K-3*

Set out on an adventure where you will travel to a distant land and become a wildlife illustrator who studies and draws a live animal in the classroom. Students will learn the power of observation and fun drawing techniques.

Eric Carle's Collages *Grades K-5*

Imagine, Draw, Paint, Cut and Collage! Explore the unique collage process of author and illustrator Eric Carle. Learn about Eric Carle, read his books, look at his illustrations, and make your own ideas come to life in this fun afterschool program that can be modified for 2 visits-8 visits. Short visits will make collages. Longer programs will work on developing narrative writing to accompany their collaged creations.

One – 60 Minute Session: \$150 (or ten students at \$15 each)
Four – 60 Minute Sessions: \$550 (or ten students at \$55 each)
Six – 60 Minute Sessions: \$800 (or ten students at \$80 each)
Twelve - 60 Minute Sessions: \$1,500 (or ten students at \$150 each)
Cost is based on the length and number of programs in a series.
